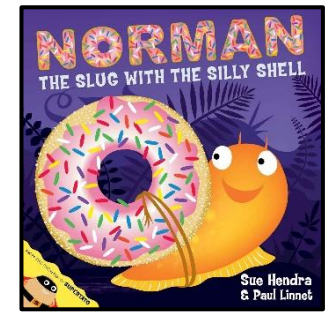
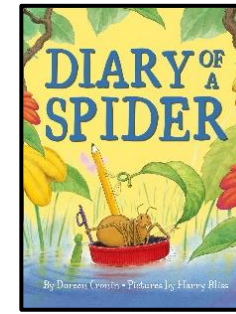




Year 2 – Spring 2 – Wriggle and Crawl

Maths:

We will spend the majority of this term learning about time. This will include looking at the difference between the hour and minute hands as well as using the 5-minute intervals to help us tell the time. We will also look at terminology such as half past, quarter past and quarter to. Towards the end of this topic, we will explore how we can calculate lengths of times and compare between different durations.

In the last week of term, we will be learning about statistics and how we can read graphs to find information. Specifically, we will be looking at pictograms which links to our computing.

English: Reading and Writing

In our reading this term, we will be focusing on all of our reading skills including prediction, retrieval, and inference. The two books we are looking at this term are 'Diary of a Spider' and 'Norman the slug with the silly shell'.

Our writing genres this term include non-chronological reports and narratives. We will be using grammar features such as apostrophes, conjunctions, and adverbs.

Wider Curriculum

Science: In this unit, children will learn that living things need air, water and food and that they grow. They will be able to identify if objects are living, non-living or have never lived.

Geography: We will be researching and exploring maps. We will be learning about the human and physical features of areas such as London and Northampton.

PSHE: We will be exploring how we can be healthy in the body and mind.

Computing: Our computing is based on Pictograms. Children will be learning how to organise and collect data.

RE: Our RE this term is building on our knowledge of the Christian religion. We will be looking at the Easter story and Holy week.
