Maths:

This term we will investigate the multiplication facts for 2, 5 and 10 and 3, 4 and 7. We will look at patterns and repetitions to help us memorise the facts. We will then move onto related division facts.

English: Reading and Writing

In our reading this term, we will be focusing on reading skills including prediction, retrieval and inference. Pupils read aloud to staff daily and are encouraged to read at home each day too.

Our writing genres this term include diaries and reports. We will focus on full stops, capital letters and conjunctions.

Wider Curriculum

Science: This term, pupils will learn that living things need air, water and food to grow. We will plant seeds and watch them grow. We will identify whether objects are living, non-living or have never lived.

Geography: In this unit, pupils will understand the key aspects of physical geography with a focus on how mountains and volcanoes are formed. We will discuss natural disasters, such as volcanoes and earthquakes. Pupils will make models of volcanoes and research examples including Pompeii.

PSHE: This term we focus on anger, what it does to the body and how to regulate ourselves when we feel angry.

RE: Our RE this term is learning about the Christian religion, looking at the Easter story and Holy week.
