



## Year 1 Summer Term 2: Curriculum



This term Year 1 will learn about how Northampton is different to India in Geography, and in RE we will be covering the topic 'Caring for our world and the people in it'. In Science, the children will continue to learn about the structure of plants, and in PSHE we will introduce and study the topic of 'Changing Me'. Our computing lessons we will continue to be based on programming.

### English:

As always, we will be continuing to build the children's vocabulary this term. We will be reading 'Monkey Puzzle' written by Julia Donaldson and this will give us the opportunity to learn about riddles and develop our skills of writing non-chronological reports. We will then read 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea' by Judith Kerr, and our lessons will focus on speech within the text, as well as expanding our understanding of narratives. We will also spend time looking at the vocabulary used throughout each story and use our knowledge to answer comprehension questions.

### Maths:

This term Year 1 focus on measuring length and height, weight and mass, volume and capacity and finally position and direction. We will then continue to develop the children's ability to work with higher numbers, count with precision and use various methods and techniques to represent number.

### Phonics:

Please ensure your child continues to practise Read Write Inc sounds at home on a regular basis. This will not only enhance the children's knowledge, and allow them to learn new sounds but encourage them to apply them in the writing too.

### Ways to help at home:

Listen to your child read at **least three times a week**. Every child takes home a fluency reading book and a RWInc book. *Please use the reading record to note down when you have read with your child.*

Support with the weekly **homework** and **spellings**. Also encourage your child to practise reading and writing the Year 1 common exception words.

Spend time recalling number, and counting with accuracy - this will help the children become more confident and fluent when working with number.

### Other information:

- PE will take place on a **THURSDAY** afternoon.
- Homework will be set every Wednesday, and expected to be completed by the following Monday. Spellings will also be given out and tested on a Wednesday. **HOMEWORK MUST BE COMPLETED ON THE CHILDRENS OFFICE 365 ACCOUNT.**
- Please can ALL children bring a water bottle to school with them, as well as a coat for playtimes and lunch time.
