


## Year 2 - Traditional Tales - Autumn 2

### English: Reading and Writing

Our theme for this term is Traditional Tales and we will be reading 'The Three Little Pigs' and 'Little Red Riding Hood'. We will then look at the story 'The Little Hen and The Great War'. In all three books we will explore themes and topics through drama and continue to develop our reading skills such as inference and retrieval.

In our writing, we will be writing narratives and discussions using all our writing skills including conjunctions and past tense. We will also develop our knowledge of the structures in our writing for example, using for and against arguments.

### Maths:

We will start off the term refreshing our place value skills within numbers to 100. We will also be recapping our skills in adding and subtracting 2-digit numbers with renaming and exchanging.

Once we have recapped our previous skills, we will then begin to look at multiplication and division with a focus on equal groups within the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Children will be using a variety of resources and methods to help develop their knowledge and skills.

### Wider Curriculum

**Science:** This term we are continuing to look at materials but with a focus on their uses. We will be investigating the properties of items to see their suitability for their purpose.

**Geography:** This term in geography we will be looking at where our food comes from. During this topic we will cover the seven continents and five oceans.

**PSHE:** We will be exploring cultural differences in our world around us.

**Computing:** Our computing is based on digital painting. We will be using various apps on the iPads to explore creativity digitally.

**RE:** Our RE this term is based on the Christian Christmas story looking at the messages delivered and received throughout.

**PE** is on a Monday – Please make sure your child has PE kit in school to get changed into.

Library and Reading books will be changed every Monday.

Homework is set every Wednesday and is due the following Wednesday.

Spellings will be given out on a Friday for the following Friday.
