

An Invitation to our Open Days

We would like to invite each and every family to a special Open Day next week.

From Monday 8th November, we will be hosting a series of open days for parents so that you can celebrate your child's work and enjoy a tour of the new specialist provision (Treetops) at the same time. Below is a list that sets out the Open Days dates for each year group.

On your child's Open Day, you will need to bring your child to school in the morning via the new Treetops entrance (this will be signposted from the playground). Please be aware that you will not be able to access your child's classroom on this day, nor will it be possible to access Treetops via the school's main office. Your child's class teacher and support staff will be there to meet your child and take them to class once the Open Day sessions are over.

Once inside, we will ask adults and children to follow the one way system. Your child's school books will be available to look at and we will be offering free light refreshments to be enjoyed in the new courtyard. In addition, there will be the opportunity to complete a questionnaire about your experience of Blackthorn Primary.

At the end of the school day, your child will need to be collected from Treetops. This will allow parents to stay and look around whether in the morning or at collection time. If your child is in Years 5 and 6 and has permission to walk home, then this will still apply. We do, however, very much hope that our parents of children in Years 5 and 6 will be able to join us to celebrate their children's work.

Afternoon Open Day Session—3:00pm to 3:30pm

Covid Precautions:

Staff will be wearing masks and we recommend that parents and carers might like to do the same. Hand sanitiser and wipes will be used on all surfaces. In addition, the building will be thoroughly ventilated, a one way system will operate and we ask that refreshments are enjoyed outside with rubbish disposed of in the large black bin.
